

Care Instructions

Genuine Leather may be subject to texture distortion when persistently set against other items.

Beware of color transfer to or from other colored objects especially in case there is lack of leather lining.

In order to safeguard the original condition of the product you are advised to:

1. Keep it in a cool, dry place protected against the sun rays
2. Keep it away from synthetic liquids and materials that may stain it
3. If your item comes in contact with water or any of the above substances, gently wipe clean with a dry, absorbent cloth.

Suede products need extra protection. Please see below our suggested instructions:

1. Avoid to wear your pieces during a rainy or snowy day. If that happens and your piece becomes wet, let it dry naturally and then if there are little spots, dab them with a dry cloth.
2. Gently brush, with suede brush, your items regularly to keep it soft and clean (alternatively you may wipe them with a clean cloth). When a suede item gets exposed or dirty it tends to harden.
3. Generally, spots in suede can be removed with a white sponge.

Store your items in their dust bag and never to a plastic bag.
